 - Noted that 2771 needs an oil change soon + will be due for inspection. It was also noted that the front end should be checked. Discussion that inspection and oil change could possibly be done by a local vendor.
 - Dusty noted about transmission leak of the output shaft on 2713. Will need to watch and Tim is supposed to call Har-Rob.
- Bill
 - Nothing to report still same issues with pagers and batteries. We have some batteries need for G3's – was discussed that it's a fairly quick turn around time for delivery.
 - 911 signs will be putting up. Might hold off on materials with the higher price costs, but hopes to work on Town of Jefferson next.

 - o Airpack checks will need to be done soon from MES can schedule for August.
